Information on enrolment in an intensive class



Dear pupils,
Dear parents,

we have been assigned you, dear pupil. Welcome to the Wilhelm-von-Oranien-Schule in Dillenburg! We are very much looking forward to welcoming you and your parents. We know that this situation is not easy. Many things are new and unfamiliar. Also, communication is difficult at the beginning because of the different languages. However, we want to do our best to make the start as easy and smooth as possible for all new pupils, so that everyone feels at home quickly.

It makes sense for a parent or other accompanying person to come along on the first day of school. The first day of school usually ends at around 13:00h.

Pupils should bring the following with them to this first day of school:

- Writing pad and pen
- Food for the breaks (drink, snack...)

Everything else that is needed will be clarified on the first day of class.

The lessons take place in so-called "intensive classes". What is an intensive class?

Intensive classes are used to acquire basic knowledge of the German language. Intensive classes usually last one year and prepare the transition to regular classes. In addition to language classes, other subjects are also taught, such as mathematics, English or sports. In some hours of the week, the pupils in the intensive classes are also divided up and attend the regular lessons of other classes. There they get to know their German classmates.

In addition to the morning classes from 07:55 to 13:00, we also offer sports and other activities on some afternoons.

Since 25th April 2022 there are intensive classes at our school. New pupils are assigned to these classes. We also have Ukrainian teachers who can help from the first day of school in their own language.


Another note on the way to school: Ukrainians who flee to Germany because of the war in their country can use all local public transport (ÖPNV) buses and trains here free of charge. In the RMV area, this applies to all local trains, i.e. suburban trains, regional trains and regional express trains as well as underground trains, trams and buses. A valid Ukrainian identity document is valid as a ticket. This regulation is valid until further notice.
